

## **Rlnfra Empanelled as SCADA/DMS Consultant with Power Finance Corporation**

- **Rlnfra empanelled out of 12 applicants**

**Mumbai, October 3, 2009:** Reliance Infrastructure Limited (Rlnfra), a unit of Anil Dhirubhai Ambani Group (ADAG) with interest in the infrastructure and power utilities, has been empanelled as SCADA/DMS (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition / Distribution Management System) Consultant.

With this, Rlnfra has become the only entity with presence in all tracks of GOI's R-APDRP opportunities including IT consultancy, IT implementation agency and SCADA/DMS consultancy.

The SCADA/DMS system is to be implemented in urban areas with more than 400,000 populations. The state utility wanting to utilize funds under R-APDRP needs to appoint SCADA/DMS Consultants (SDC) empanelled with Power Finance Corporation (PFC). The SDC shall assist the utility in successful implementation of SCADA/DMS project.

Notably, SCADA/DMS helps Utilities monitor and control the electrical network and coordinate the maintenance and fault rectification activities of the electrical distribution system.

The process of empanelment was initiated by PFC in August, 2009. Rlnfra has been empanelled out of 12 applicants.

Further, State utilities will float the request for proposal for SCADA/DMS consultancy and only the empanelled companies can participate in it.

The Gol's R-APDRP program focuses on actual, demonstrable performance in terms of sustained loss reduction. It also intends, improving customer service through real time monitoring of distribution network with SCADA/DMS systems. The total size of Part A of this program covering IT Applications & SCADA/DMS is Rs 10,000 crore.

Rlnfra has presence in all the verticals of R-APDRP. In March this year, Rlnfra was empanelled as the Information Technology (IT) Implementation Agency with PFC, for implementing information technologies in State Electricity Boards (SEB).
