Mumbai, January 14, 2009: National Safety Council of India (NSCI) conferred on the prestigious '**Shrestha Suraksha Puraskar 2007**' to Reliance Infrastructure Limited's Dahanu Thermal Power Station in the manufacturing sector category. The prestigious award comes to the power station for adopting the world class systems and practices as well as its outstanding contribution in occupational health and safety. This year, Dahanu Thermal Power Station was the only thermal power station, to win this prestigious award.

In a function held at Nehru Centre, Worli, Mumbai on Saturday, 10th January 2009, Shri Oscar Fernandes, Hon. Union Minister of State for Labour & Unemployment presented the prestigious award to the jubilant team of the power station, headed by Shri Prasad Rao, Station Head & Vice President.

Every year, since 1998, the National Safety Council of India, an organization set up with the aim of generating, developing and sustaining a movement on occupational health and safety, presents these awards. The award is aimed at recognizing and encouraging development and implementation of effective occupational health and safety management system and through it achieving meritorious and sustained performance.

This year, there was an overwhelming response by the participating units in the manufacturing sector category, wherein 264 applications were filed with the council for the award. Out of these, only 117 could qualify by securing 75% and above. RInfra's Dahanu Thermal Power Station secured 93.91% to win the award.

Reliance Infrastructure's state-of-the-art thermal power station generates 500 MW power through its two units of 250MW each. Situated approximately 120 kms from Mumbai on the Western Sea coast, the power plant works within strict environment and pollution control regime and this is reflected in the fact that its emissions are much lower than the limit prescribed by entities like Central Pollution Control Board, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and World Bank.

The power plant was commissioned in 1995 and is constantly upgraded to maintain its technological edge via-a-vis national and global counterparts.

The plant has all certifications, viz., ISO 9001 for quality systems, ISO 14001 for environmental practices, OHSAS 18000 for occupational health and safety practices and SA 8000 for adopting practices related to the Social Accountability; thus the power station has a distinct recognition of being the only power station in the country to have been certified with all the above quality certifications.
